

**Letter From Todd Kennedy**  
*President and Chief Executive Officer, Providence Hospital*

Dear Supporters,

Fiscal year 2021 has seen our fight against COVID-19 continue, and Ascension Providence has maintained our focus on keeping our staff, physicians, patients and community safe by working to get our community vaccinated. Unfortunately, COVID-19 is still with us and as I write this message, Mobile is seeing a spike due to the Delta variant. However, it is something Ascension Providence has adapted to and is prepared to handle. With the Foundation's support, we have been successful in continuing to provide the best healthcare possible as well as began multiple projects across our health ministry to provide better care and access to our community.


In Fiscal Year 2020, Ascension Providence led the way in working with the Mobile City Council to pass universal masking to protect our community and local hospital and health system resources so that we could continue elective case volumes and reduce COVID-19 transmissions. This year, Ascension Providence worked with local church partnerships to offer vaccinations to as many members of our community as possible.

In the midst of the pandemic, we also made great strides in quality and patient satisfaction. Ascension Providence achieved Mobile's only 4 Star CMS hospital quality score as well as achieved Mobile's only A rating from Leapfrog, a quality ranking non-profit organization specifically focused on improving healthcare outcomes. As you might imagine, Ascension Providence administration is extremely proud of our physicians, clinicians, ancillary and support staff that made all of this possible during a very difficult time.

Along with quality improvements, Ascension Providence invested over \$5 million dollars in new equipment, including a new state of the art Catheterization lab, and over \$2 million in building improvements around the campus. Our Ascension brand was also rolled out to the market and signage around our clinics, campus, and acute care hospital were updated to reflect that brand. Our Ascension Medical Group has worked to expand and has recruited bariatric surgery, general surgery, gastroenterology, and multiple new primary care physicians to serve across our network.

These were just a few of many projects that occurred in FY 21 to better visitor, patient, and clinician experience here at Providence. All of these changes were not without struggle, but the improvements they bring continue to strengthen Providence's abilities to continue to serve our Mobile community.

My thanks go out to each and every patient, friend and associate who supported Ascension Providence, our health system and the Foundation's work. Fiscal Year 2021 was a challenging year, not only for Providence but for our entire nation. With your support, we look forward with confidence to continuing to deliver the best in patient-centered, faith-based healthcare. We also continue to pray for a COVID-19 free 2022.
