For decades, edmund t. AHEE Jewelers of Grosse Pointe Woods has brought joy to countless people with its stunning rings, necklaces, bracelets and other fine wares. Likewise, the Ahee family has brightened many lives over the years through generous philanthropic gifts.

The Ahees began their strong relationship with St. John Hospital & Medical Center (SJHMC) shortly after family

patriarch Edmund Ahee relocated his business to its present location in 1968.

"St. John is such a valuable resource for the community," says John Ahee, company Vice President and youngest son of Edmund and Bettejean Ahee. "My wife Connie and I have great respect for so many St. John physicians and staff. In the Ahee family, 31 children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren were born at St. John. And three more are on the way. Over the years, our family has received care from every sort of medical unit—including lifesaving care."

Edmund and Bettejean's deep admiration of SJHMC led to many fundraising efforts. Edmund was a lifetime member of THE GUILD of SJHMC until his passing in 1999. Bettejean, Ahee Jewelers CEO, is a lifetime Fontbonne Auxiliary member. She also chaired the Fontbonne's annual fashion show in 1984, was honored for her commitment to the Fontbonne at the first "Girl's Night Out" event in 2007, served on the Fontbonne board and was a member of the Cornerstone Society.

In addition to being a lifetime Guild member, John is a past board member of the Van Elslander Cancer Center (VECC) and The Holley Institute. He and Connie also co-chaired a Champions for Life event at Comerica Park in 2005 to support the Meade Pediatric Hematology/ Oncology Center at the VECC.

Ahee Jewelers also generously supports SJHMC. In 2005, to aid fundraising efforts for SJHMC's cardiovascular research and to create awareness of the hospital's comprehensive cardiovascular services, Ahee Jewelers donated 300 lovely sterling silver heart necklaces to the "One Heart Can Make All the Difference" campaign. The family also established the Edmund T. Ahee Endowment Fund for Cardiac Research.

"We support cardiac care because several people in the family have had heart issues," John says. "We're currently partnering with St. John on a similar fundraiser by donating and supplying heart bracelets to benefit the St. John Providence Cardiovascular Center of Excellence."

The church is a family cornerstone, and the Ahees shared a deep and long-lasting friendship with Sr. Verenice McQuade.

"Sr. Verenice was my idol," Bettejean says. "Her contributions to St. John Hospital were priceless. Her innovations still impact much of the success enjoyed by the hospital today. Those who had the

privilege of knowing her concur that she possessed saintly qualities. I was truly honored to call her my dear friend."

With a family as large as the Ahees, McQuade Society membership has been invaluable.

"The McQuade Society has been a godsend," Bettejean says. "We've had numerous occasions when medical intervention was immediately required. John says when his father passed away, the family made a conscious decision to extend his legacy of giving.

"Dad was a well-known philanthropist," John says. "During his wake, so many people told us about the things he did to help people, even as a young and struggling business owner. We decided to carry on our parents' legacy by continuing to give to organizations like Capuchin and St. John that mean so much to our community."
