RECOVERY COACH PROGRAM SAVES LIVES

As part of Ascension Wisconsin's efforts to address substance use disorders, we have expanded our recovery coach program to Ascension Wisconsin emergency departments serving the Oshkosh and Fox Valley communities due to grant funding. Recovery coaches provide emotional support, help individuals overcome barriers to recovery and make connections to community resources to support their recovery.

To ensure all patients have access to these services, Mercy Health Foundation is proud to be a partner in this program, covering referral costs for those patients who do not qualify under the grant terms, such as people struggling with alcohol use disorder. Apricity is our local program partner, providing a full spectrum of substance use disorder care and recovery coach referrals at Ascension Mercy Hospital.

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Robin Kobilic, Manager of Emergency Services at Ascension Mercy Hospital, shared that the staff really appreciates having the program as a resource for this high risk population.

“The addition of the ED2 recovery coach program has been a huge help for our community,” Robin said. “The ER nurses are grateful to have another resource to offer our patients. It has been very well received by patients and having someone present to speak with them within an hour of the call has really opened opportunities for these patients.”

“They now have contact information for the recovery coach that they can reach out to at any time which helps prevent readmission and gives the patient more control to get the help and resources they need. Thank you to the Foundation for helping to make this possible.”

MISSION STATEMENT

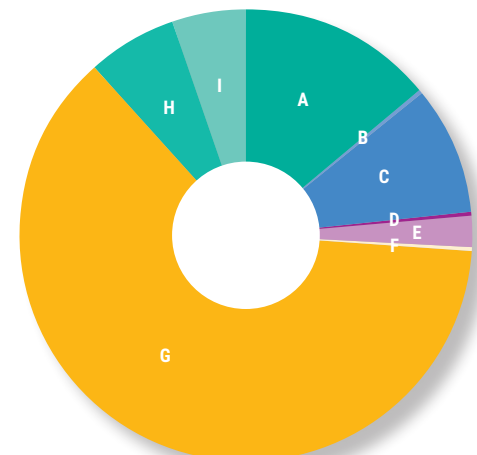
