

INSTRUCTIONS FOR LEGACY AFFINITY MEDICAL GROUP SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

The student is responsible to submit the entire application in one submission. The committee **WILL NOT** follow up with the student in regards to any missing piece of the scholarship, nor will the committee hold any incomplete applications. It is the responsibility of the student to submit their **ONE** complete application with all the appropriate pieces electronically.

Submit the following information with your application:

- Most current high school transcript along with ACT and/or SAT scores.
- Description of Extracurricular Activities and Employment, including but not limited to:
 - Athletic, music, drama, forensics, and clubs. Include the years in which you participated in these activities.
 - Leadership roles, including student government. Include the years in which you participated in these activities.
 - Special honors, awards, and recognition.
 - Community and church activities, including volunteer experiences. List the amount of volunteer time devoted to these activities.
- Work experiences, including dates worked and hours per week.
- Letters of Recommendation and Student Evaluation Checklists.
 - Two letters of recommendation from two different teachers, counselors or administrators confirming the student's good standing and intent to graduate. A completed student evaluation checklist must accompany each letter of recommendation. Print the forms from the main application page.
 - Note: All letters of recommendation must be submitted with the student's entire application.

In addition to the above information, you are required to complete the Personal Statement and Special Essay on the application.

- **Personal Statement.** In 600 words or less, typed, please discuss your career objectives, plans for schooling in the subsequent academic year, and qualifications for the academic pursuits selected. Please elaborate on a particular challenge or circumstances that had an impact on you and your family over your

academic career. Please explain how you dealt with or addressed that challenge.

- **Special Essay.** There is no final or “correct” answer. In 800 words or less, typed, please discuss the following topic: *In your own words define servant leadership and how you plan to be a servant leader in healthcare.*
